



A TRIBUTE TO LEE V. HALLOWELL

The staff of this paper on behalf of the Class of 1975 would like to extend their warm admiration and sincere gratitude to our Superintendent of Schools, Mr. Lee V. Hallowell. After more than thirty-five years devoted to the field of education, Mr. Hallowell will retire from his active career this year.

Mr. Hallowell is a native of Edmunds, Maine, a small community downeast in Washington County for which he has a strong affection. He and Mrs. Hallowell have a summer place where Mr. Hallowell plans to spend a portion of his retirement fishing in the trout brooks or going deep sea fishing, doing gardening and perhaps a little sketching or painting of which he has a hidden talent.

After graduation from Machias Normal School, now the University of Maine at Machias, Mr. Hallowell continued his studies at Boston University from which he received his B. Ed. degree in 1939. Before World War II began, he was principal of an elementary school in Readfield, later at Stewartstown, N. H., and then at Brooklyn and Southbury, Connecticut. The war interrupted his teaching career for three years during which he served in the U.S. Navy. In 1947 Mr. Hallowell received his Master's Degree in Education from the University of Maine. Shortly after his discharge he accepted a position as principal of the Hanibal Hamlin School in Bangor where he was administrator for two years and then he was transferred to the Fifth Street Junior High where he served until 1959. In the latter year he became Superintendent of Schools in Brewer where he has spent the past sixteen years as Superintendent of the Brewer school system.

There's the third Parker, Steve, throwing eggs at Bangor High School. Laurel Sullivan sells cars, Janet McClay is a shoe salesman, Leonard Ford isn't available for comment, and Robert Ryan makes watches. Shelly Lancaster is married to Paul, (the cigar salesman) Lori Grover is a hockey pro, and Jay Savoy is a movie star.

Marco Woods makes furniture, Roberta York is an artist and Aimee Leach is a softball catcher. Tanya Bickford is a pole-vaulter, Jeff Butterfield owns a dairy, Tim Hogan owns a carwash, and Roseanne Houston owns a flower shop.

Lorita Gray is an orthodontist, Denise Bosse' is the precision-aire chaperone, Dale Hurd is a radio announcer and Carla Foss is the boss of a newspaper. Wayne Robichaud and Steve Gray are in the baker business, Charles Randall is an acrobatic performer in the Barnum and Bailey Circus, and Beverly Wilson owns a girdle manufacturing company. Kevin Faloon plays professional broomball, Rhonda Cameron makes lingerie, Mike White and Morton Frye are basketball coaches.

Bill French makes french fries, Randy Sawyer is the president of a cheese factory, and Carol Eastman makes film. Michael McKay is a Latin Major in college, Bill Nichols is a student teacher, George Nelson is a barber, Andrew Bowden is a pencil-lead manufacturer, and Pat Clark is a used-car salesman. Also on the bottom of the front page I see a large photograph taken by Bruce Theriault, a professional photographer. It is a picture of Bruce Niles, the note-worthy astronomer. I see on the sports page that Jane Peasley is still playing for the Red Sox, even though she owns a chain of gas stations. I walk outside and see Dan Morgan, a full-time typist and secretary for Footman's Dairy, drive by in a blue-green Rambler. His numerous secretaries include Debbie Hamilton, Brenda MacLeod, and Kathy Bishop. The people running the computers and counting money are Diane Scribner and Cindy DeBeck. Of course the head teller at the bank is Terry Fago. The travel course now heads us South to Florida where we see JoAnne Evans and Barbara Wood still getting a tan. Kathy Wood and Gayle Wood work at Disneyworld. What they're doing we're not going to tell. If you get too bad a sunburn at Florida, you can always go to the head nurse at Fort Lauderdale, Jan Willis. Well, it's time to leave the sun and see what some of our classmates are doing up North in Maine. Well look, there is Tom Buckley playing hockey for the Boston Bruins. Jackie Corbett and Terry Grant are out snowmobiling at Lucerne Lake. We happened to drive by old Brewer High and out in the yard was Vaughn Knowles, Bob Murphy and Keith Drew still running sprints in their gym shorts. A little more flabby, I must say. Leslie Luke teaches English now for all our children. Mary Parlee and Patty Norton just rode by bombing around as usual. Darrell Pluard is now head janitor at the high school. Kim Thompson and Judy Ogilvie did so well in Home Economics they now teach their own sewing course. Giselle McGinn and Linda Giles are still in Chemistry trying to find their last unknown. Laurie Neill is still punching keys at Sampson's. Martha Maines now has her Master's Degree. We're all very proud of her.

Ms. Jackie McCormack is now an accountant for Sharon Wadsworth's multi-billion dollar Art School. Did you know Julie Larson is now head cook at Jed Prouty's? Kathy Donovan is now the chief of police for Brewer, a step forward for womanhood we feel. Paula Gilleland will x-ray any bones that you want looked at.
